#### **Séptimos:**

- Verb TO BE: Example: She **is** a student. She **isn't** a teacher.
- Can: Example: I **can run** very fast. I **can't ride** a bike.
- There is – There are: Example: **There is** a car outside. **There isn't** a bike.
- Prepositions (in, on, under, between, in front of, next to). Example: The cat is **on** the table.
- Present Simple (routines). Example: I **go** to school from Monday to Friday.
- The Time: Example: It's **half past** seven.
- Frequency Adverbs: Example: I **usually** get up at 7.
- Present Continuous (actions happening now): Example: She **is playing** the violin.
- Vocabulary: Clothes

#### **Octavos:**

- Simple Past (R – I): Example: I **drove** my car last night.
- Present Simple (routines). Example: I **get up at** 6 am every day.
- Present Continuous (actions happening now): Example: She **is working out** at the sports center.
- Quantifiers: Example: I have **some** friends in this school.
- Adjectives: People's Descriptions. Examples: She has **long straight** hair.

#### **Primeros Medios:**

- Simple Past (R – I): Example: I **finished** my homework this morning.
- Comparatives and Superlatives: I am **taller** than John but Paul is **the tallest**.
- Quantifiers: Example: I have **lots** of friends but **few** close friends.
- Future Tenses: Be Going to - Present Continuous - Will

#### **Segundos Medios:**

- Present Perfect (for, since, just, already, yet): Example: I **'ve worked** here since 2005.
- Simple Past (R – I): Example: I **finished** reading the book yesterday.
- Passive Voice: Example: A bank **was robbed** last night.
- Future Tenses: Be Going to - Present Continuous - Will

#### **Terceros Medios:**

- Past Perfect: Example: When I got home, my mom **had gone** out.
- Phrasal Verbs (lista del libro): Example: Susan **broke up** with her boyfriend.
- Second Conditional: Example: If I **had** time, I **would help** you.
- Adverbs of manner: Example: He did the exercise **quickly**.
- Too – Enough: Example: This soup is **too** hot. – I am not rich **enough** to buy a new car.
- Would like – Rather: Example: I **would like** to travel soon. – I **would rather** travel soon.
